Even though the HSI eligibility designation has a 25% enrollment threshold,

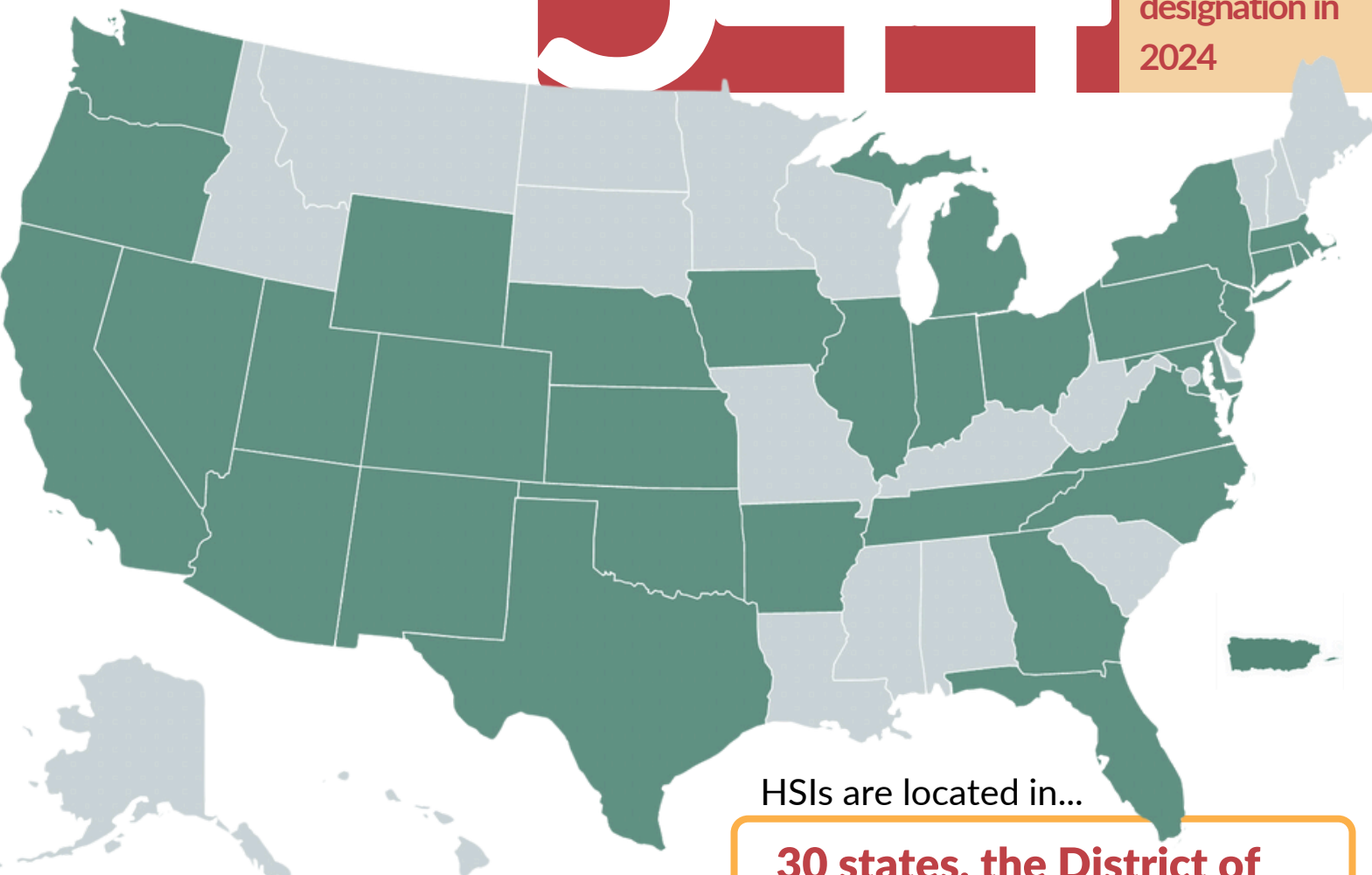
**45%**
