

Why Historically Black Colleges and Universities Matter

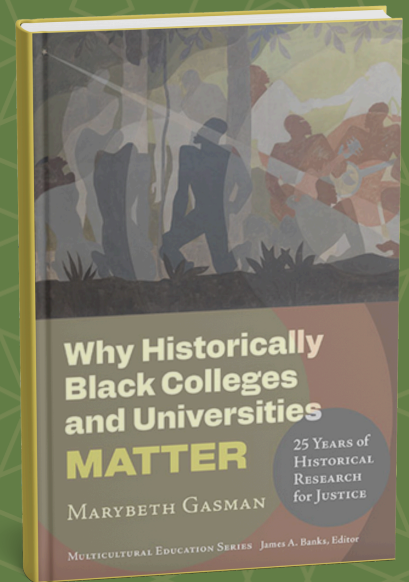
